## Wisconsin River Power Company Closes Several Boat Landings Due to High Water

### Affected Landings Will be Barricaded Until Water Recedes

**Necedah, WI** – As a precautionary measure, Wisconsin River Power Company (WRPCO) will temporarily barricade the entrances of several boat landings along the Wisconsin River between Nekoosa and Castle Rock Dam due to high water and a fast flowing river. The affected landings are in areas of concentrating fast flows that would make operating water craft extremely dangerous.

River flows are expected to peak sometime Wednesday. WRPCO will reopen the landings after flows subside sometime later in the week, depending on precipitation levels over the next several days.

The decision to close the landings comes after discussions between WRPCO and county emergency management agencies.
