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WRPCO Begins Shoreline Stabilization Project at Castle Rock Flowage

Necedah, WI – Wisconsin River Power Company (WRPCO) will work to repair some shoreline erosion on the Castle Rock Flowage beginning in early August and lasting through the remainder of the summer. The work, which includes adding rip-rap, planting vegetation, and re-sculpturing the shoreline, will be done on-shore and should not disrupt recreational use of the flowage. In the interest of public safety, the construction area will be temporarily off-limits to the public during the course of the work. Access to the work area from both the river and the land will be prohibited.

“As part of our FERC license, we perform shoreline stabilization activities on the Castle Rock and Petenwell flowages,” said Virgil Schlorke, WRPCO Supervisor of Regional Generation.

Schlorke added that the work is expected to be completed by November.
