**Portion of Petenwell Wildlife Area Open to the Public
for 2008 Whitetail Deer Archery Hunting**

Wisconsin River Power Company (WRPCO) will open a portion of the Petenwell Wildlife Area to the general public for the whitetail deer archery season. The area that will be open to the public for archery hunting is the area from the Strongs Prairie Cemetery east to 20th Avenue and north of Chicago Drive. The rest of the Petenwell Wildlife Area will remain closed to hunting.

The area will be open for archery hunting from September 13 to October 5 and again from October 14 through the end of the archery hunting season.

The entire Petenwell Wildlife Area will be closed to ALL public access from October 6 to October 13 to facilitate a disabled firearms deer hunt. All public access is restricted during this time to ensure public safety.

Please remember that devices that could damage trees—including permanent tree stands—are not allowed. Tree stands must be removed at the end of each day.
